- ► Large deposits: 10-150 million tons
- ► High grade in nature
- Typically low cost mines

#### Examples:

Cinco de Mayo (Mag Silver) - \$2B market cap Taylor Deposit (Arizona Mining) - bought for \$1.8B by South 32



► Hosts the Silvertip Mine (Coeur Mining Ltd.)







#### Project Similarities to Silvertip


- Comparable high grades

  - ► Very high grade, same geology

  - potential small open pit deposits

















**Figure 5: Exploration Potential of The Silverknife Prospect Silverknife Project** 423750 423250 Historical resource of 363,880 Legend tons with average assay Drill Collars 2023 values of 511 g/t Ag, 3.7 g/t Au, Historic Drill 12.5% Pb and 4.8% Zn. Collars Claim Boundary **Geological Legend** Areas of prospectivity = = = Assumed Fault Road River Shale Kechika/Atan Sediments Cassiar Intrusive **Geochemical Anomalies** Ag\_1500ppb Pb\_100ppm Zn\_300ppm Datum 423250 423500 423750 Cesar Symonds March, 2024


#### Silverknife - Limited Modern Exploration

- 2023: only 1400 meters of drilling into the Silverknife Prospect
- Key Intercepts
  - ▶ 16.2m of 11,379 g/t Zn
  - 2.7 m 0.31 g/t gold, 51.7 g/t silver
  - 4.0 m 0.20 g/t gold, 56.01 g/t silver
  - 0.5 m 881 g/t silver, 5,060 g/t lead
- Major Fault Extensions identified
- Defined extent of the Heat Source - Cassiar




#### Tootsee North -Priority Target 2024

- Same Geology that Hosts Silvertip - McDame Limestone
- Adjacent to heat source
- ► Target is large can fit Silvertip Mine into it
- Access and water
   availability year round potential to drill in the
   fall



### Silverknife and Amy



#### Amy - Likely CRD - 8km from Silvertip - our next Great project!

- Classic carbonate replacement style deposit hosted in limestone
- Underground development of 633 feet of drifts and 202 feet of crosscuts
- Extensive historical database of geochemical, geological and geophysical data



## Amy - Spectacular Historical Grades

- ► 200 ft strike sample in 4450 level adit graded
- ▶ 20.74 oz/t silver
- ▶ 5.17% lead
- > 7.46% zinc








#### 2024 Goals and Uses of Funds

- Silverknife (\$300,000)
  - Complete site access
  - ► Identify drill targets in Tootsee North
  - Geophysical IP surveys on all targets to identify sulfide mineralization
  - Detailed geological and structural mapping
  - Possible fall drilling program
- ► Amy (\$50,000)
  - New access route evaluation
  - Mapping and Prospecting
  - Permitting
- Silver Hart (\$50,000)
  - ► Evaluate new targets
  - Initiate studies to examine the potential for DMS/Ore sorting technologies for small scale mine development

#### **Current Opportunities**

- Next door to a \$50M + exploration play TONS OF ACTIVITY and NEW KNOWLEDGE
- Significant interest in Silverknife due to proximity to Silvertip, same geology, and regional structural controls
- Silver Hart new targets and evaluation of economics for small scale development
- Amy Another CRD being staged to be come the "next project"
